
Transport Outlook 2050

The main drivers of transport developments between 2017 and 2050 are population growth (+21%) (with higher growth in cities) and GDP growth (+1.4% per year).

Passenger transport use increases by 11%. Public transport as well as walking and cycling form a greater share of the **modal split**, as the graph shows.



Freight transport use (tonne-kilometres) increases by 31%. Road accounts for 2.5 percentage points less of the total.



Fewer commuter trips are made, despite population growth.

This is because more people work from home.



The distances travelled by **road freight transport** increase. In particular, the use of light commercial vehicles increases.
